



16 months after the November 2017 election, where are we?

In May 2017, Équipe Barbe Team had an ambitious program for the next four years, a program that highlights the values that are important to the team, namely: integrity, the common good, good governance, listen to the citizens and courage. On this basis, the team's candidates won all the seats available at Borough Hall on November 5, 2017.

What have we achieved from this program since?

STRATEGIC PLANNING 2018-2024

Adopted on November 5, 2018, this plan is the result of a strategic reflection exercise carried out by elected officials and the Borough's management team and determines the orientations that will guide the actions of the administration in the years to come. We are very proud to say that it reflects the values and development goals of our team and that we have already started working on them.

MAKE LASALLE A MOBILE AND INNOVATIVE BOROUGH

Proactive in the MTQ 2019 work file, we formed a Mobilization Committee and held information meetings and interviews with the concerned ministries in order to reduce the impacts of the planned work. Thus, the closure of access to LaSalle was postponed until early 2019 to reduce the damage to businesses during the holidays. We were able to reduce the problematic configuration of the Angrignon viaduct to six months instead of one year and the police officers will monitor it. Our voice has also been heard in the City Center, and the executive committee members responsible for mobility will explore different avenues to increase LaSalle mobility.

MAKE LASALLE MORE ACCESSIBLE AND MORE WELCOMING

LaSalle has an advantageous tax system: the 2018 budget has been characterized by the lowest tax increase with 0.7%, the local tax has further decreased by \$ 1.5M so that it currently represents only 11.5 % of our budget, the lowest percentage of all boroughs in Montreal.

554 building or renovation permits granted for a total value of \$ 191M, a record.

The redevelopment of the Quenneville Bay Bridge now makes this magnificent view of our coastline accessible to all clientele.

We have secured pedestrian crossings around three schools in a pilot project that is proving very satisfying.

We renewed our cultural diversity action plan and entered into a friendship pact with the Taishan district-city, China, our district with a large Taishan community.

The webcast of the council meetings began in January 2018.

DEPLOY THE ATTRACTIVE POTENTIAL AND DYNAMICITY OF LASALLE

The redevelopment of Newman Boulevard has begun.

The winner of the architectural competition for the expansion and renovation of L'Octogone has been unveiled and the preparatory work for the expansion is starting slowly. The opening of the future library is planned for 2021.

CREATING A GREEN, HEALTHY AND SUSTAINABLE ENVIRONNEMENT

A two-year cyclical pruning program has been put in place to maintain trees in good condition, clear surrounding structures and eliminate risky branches.

In many cases, street repairs resulted in a reduction in paved area and greening of the surrounding area.

AFFIRM OUR LITTORAL CHARACTER

Addition of four swings on the waterfront between 37th Avenue and Lyette Street and construction of a halt at the corner of Dupras and Boul. LaSalle

AND MORE....

A lot of money invested in the renovation of our infrastructure, \$ 2M for sidewalks, over 50 renovated streets, new water games at Dalmany Park and Lawrence Park, the renovation of the Lacharité pool had begun, we added street furniture and a new exercise area at Parent Park.

And LaSalle has reached the milestone of 80,000 inhabitants.
